



Advocacy Committee

Purpose

The Advocacy Committee of PBSA is established to fulfill the goal of effecting change for the screening profession and its stakeholders.

The Advocacy Committee will:

1. Cultivate relationships with relevant stakeholders for the benefit of the screening profession.
2. Improve relationships with consumer advocate groups and other detractors to mitigate adverse outcomes.
3. Engage users and user groups on PBSA issues that impact them.
4. Increase collaboration with appropriate strategic partners.

Reporting

The Advocacy Committee will report to the Board of Directors.

Meetings

The Advocacy Committee will meet monthly to plan for completion of goals for the current year; goals are driven by the association's strategic plan.

Configuration

The Advocacy Committee Chairs will review all sub-committees and task forces on an annual basis, and ensure that staff has a current list.

The Advocacy Committee Chair term limit is typically two years.
