

Industry Practices Committee



Purpose

The Industry Practices Committee of PBSA is established to fulfill the goal of developing a robust program for creating, reviewing, and distributing “practical guidance” for the screening profession.

The Industry Practices Committee will:

1. Increase the association’s capacity to create and vet practical guidance.
2. Enhance effectiveness of distribution channels (i.e. technology, conferences, white papers) of practical guidance.
3. Increase member awareness of practical guidance.
4. Ensure practical guidance is relevant, practical, and valuable to member CRAs.
5. Listen to the needs of the general membership and balance that knowledge with the passion of contributing committee members to shape practical guidance.

Reporting

The Industry Practices Committee will report to the Board of Directors.

Meetings

The Industry Practices Committee will meet monthly to plan for completion of goals for the current year; goals are driven by the association’s strategic plan.

Configuration

The Industry Practices Committee Chairs will review all sub-committees and task forces on an annual basis, and ensure that staff has a current list.

The Industry Practices Committee Chair term limit is typically two years.
